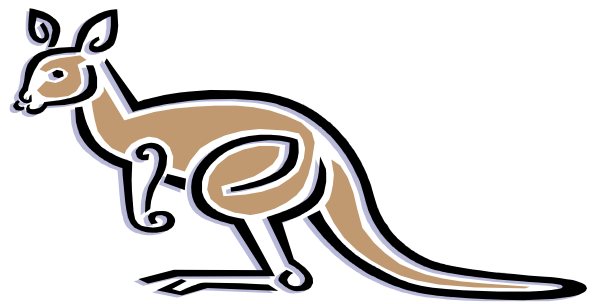


Oregon Trail District "Cubs Down Under" Day Camp 2008

Camp fees

\$30 per Cub Scout by **May 3rd**.

\$35 per Scout after May 3rd except for new Cubs.

Popcorn certificates **MUST BE** submitted with your payment. Copies required.

Boys T-shirts are included in their camp fee.

Adult T-shirts are \$5 each, 2X shirts are \$7, 3X shirts are \$8 and must be pre-ordered.

Walking Adult Leaders for Camp

Adults help guide Cub Scouts during camp and are there as positive influences and helpers.

Responsibilities include:

- Remain with the boys at all times.
- **Accompany cubs** to program areas.
- Ensure the **buddy system** is used.
- Check daily **attendance & return forms**.
- **Assist program staff** at all program areas.
- **Participate**, Please leave books home!
- Limit Cell Phone use to Emergencies.
- Maintain **discipline** in your pack (not the program staff responsibility).



Equipment Check List

Mark all belongings with Name and Pack #

CUB SCOUTS

- Day Pack to hold gear
- Lunch (lunch is from 12:10-12:40)
- Water Bottle
- Sun Screen & Insect Repellant

ADULTS

- Pen / Pencil
- Camera
- Cooler for Lunches
- Wagon (great to haul "stuff")
- All adults must wear closed toed shoes.

DO NOT BRING

- I-Pods, CD players, Electronic Devices, etc.
- Knives
- Water guns (Spray bottles for self only)

No Water Fights

- No Sandals—*everyone must wear closed toe shoes*

Things to Remember

- Insure that your Cub Scout is registered with the BSA
- Cubs and Adults must submit a Health History medical form at registration. (They are not returned).
- **Volunteer!** We need *every* parent's help to make sure we have enough adults. Walking den leaders are required at a ratio of 1 adult to every 4 boys (or portion thereof) with a minimum of 2 adults per pack.
- Additional adults are needed daily in each Station and in Tot Lot. **All adults attending day camp must attend training on June 5th 7:00pm at the LDS Church, Hermiston.**

Units are combined into Camp Dens. **Communicate and work with** the other packs in your Den.

NO ONE is to remove a child from camp without checking out at Camp Headquarters.
