What makes me a "TRAINED" Scout leader?

Cubmasters, Pack Committee Members, Den Leaders, Webelos Den Leaders, and Assistants - Complete "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" (both online) and "Cub Scout Leader Specifics" for your position

Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters (incl. LDS 11-Year Old Scout Leaders) - Complete "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" (both online), Boy Scout Leader Specifics, and Outdoor Leader Skills

Troop Committee Members Complete "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" (both online) and Troop Committee Challenge

Varsity Coaches and Assistants Complete "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" (both online), Varsity Scout Specifics, and Outdoor Leader Skills

Venture Crew Advisors and Associate Crew Advisors - Complete "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" (both online) and Venturing Specifics

Where does BIGHORN fit into this? Bighorn is supplemental and ongoing training. You still need to attend the basic training courses listed above to be rated as a TRAINED Scout leader. Bighorn provides continuing education to help you put the FUN in your Scouting program.
