The 2010 Popcorn sale can help you out! Last year, our own Pack 249 earned over \$9,000 for their unit's budget by selling over \$27,000 of popcorn. A total of 43 units earned over \$87,000 for their unit programs. The Blue Mountain Council is proud to be one of the few councils in the country to offer such a high commission rate. The national average commission level among BSA councils is only between 30% and 35%.

• Provides additional opportunities for advancements and awards in the Scouting program earning awards for Packs, Troops, Teams and Crews (26 awards available).	

The popcorn sale can help:

- Reduce financial burdens on members, so you won't have to ask members to pay to participate.
- The unit carry out low cost, meaningful activities.
- Ease the need for leaders to provide supplies.
- Encourage individual earnings.
- Allow unit not to exclude anyone from activities because of cost.

There are four different sales methods:

Show and Sell/Deliver – either take the popcorn door to door or set up a table in front of a store or other suitable location.

Parent Sale – have the parents invite their coworkers and friends to purchase popcorn.
