What is the cost? The Centennial Celebration cost is \$17 per person for the weekend. Those persons attending on Saturday only will cost \$7 per person. All participants will receive a Centennial Celebration patch. Units camping overnight should be prepared to provide their own camping equipment and food (using stoves/fires 18” off the ground.) Webelos overnight campers will camp with their Scout troop.

Beginning the day the event starts, Oct. 15, 2010, there will be no refunds. For emergency situations, (illness or injury with written documentation by a medical doctor or parent or guardian, a death in the family or unexpected relocation of the family), a 50% refund will be provided. Refund requests made after the Centennial Celebration will not be honored.
